- Any others interested?

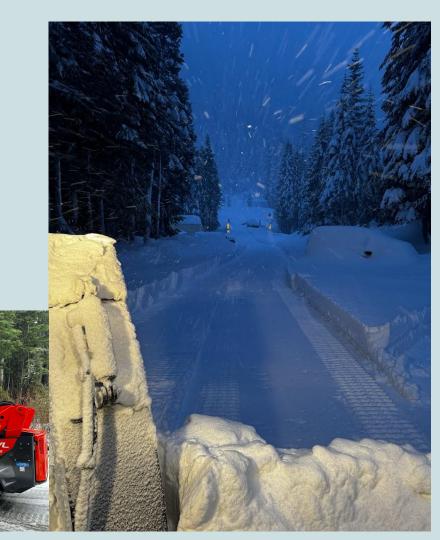


#### **Snow Removal**

Started water box upgrades. Six boxes replaced this summer, will continue at similar pace until all old boxes are upgraded. Adding meter standoffs in the process.





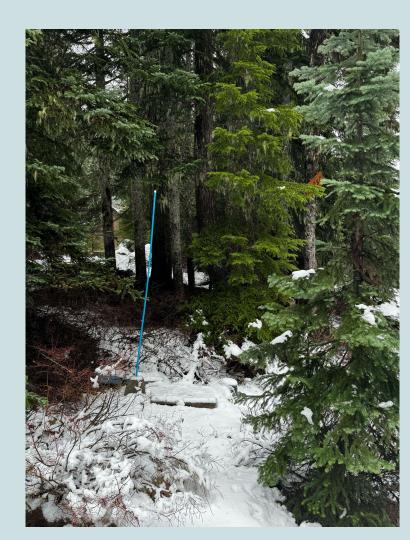
#### Fall Water Leak

#### Water Box Markers

- To help with finding water boxes in the winter, all boxes were marked with blue poles
- Thanks to Larry for making these and Ed for helping install them
- We will remove every Spring and reinstall in the Fall



#### Pump House Maintenance

- Lots of deferred maintenance done on pump house by Larry
- System is about as tight as it has ever been
- Being proactive pays off!

## Fire Coverage

- Yodelin is not covered by any Fire District
- Lake Wenatchee Fire & Rescue responded to Johnston fire, but this was on a volunteer basis (and they billed for it)
- DNR will only respond to fires on lots greater than 1 acre
- Lake Wenatchee Fire Chief would like us to establish a fire district, but probably unrealistic
- Contracting with Lake Wenatchee FD for coverage a possibility

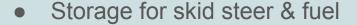
#### Lot Purchase

  - If you have a proxy vote for another member submit an additional ballot but in the name field say "[your name] as proxy for [their name]"



Voting rules are defined by a combination of: Washington State Law, Yodelin's bylaws and legal precedents
